SELEX Sistemi Integrati signs contract worth 25 million euro for air traffic control systems in Kenya

SELEX Sistemi Integrati, a Finmeccanica company, has signed a contract with the Kenya Civil Aviation Authority to supply air traffic control radar systems.

Under the contract, worth approximately 25 million euro, the company will supply primary radar, secondary radar, an automated system for the management of land-based movements and navigation aids within 15 months.

The new systems, which will be installed in the international airports of Nairobi and Mombasa and in the airports of Kisumu, Eldoret, Machacos, Poror and Wajir, will enable the whole country's air space to be controlled. The contract signed in Kenya confirms SELEX Sistemi Integrati's leadership in radar systems for air traffic control and management.
